On receipt of a notice, the Minister may recommend that the Premier give authorisation for the development application to be made to and determined by the WAPC under the significant development provisions if the Minister considers that the proposal raises issues of such State or regional importance that it would be appropriate. s.171M(2)

On the recommendation of the Minister, the Premier may give authorisation in writing for the development application to be made to and determined by the WAPC under the significant development provisions. s.171M(3)
