- 6(2)(g) to approve the appointment, for not more than two consecutive meetings, of a person nominated as a proxy for the chief executive of the department principally assisting in the administration of the *Regional Development Commissions Act 1993*
- 6(2)(h) to approve the appointment, for not more than two consecutive meetings, of a person nominated as a proxy for the chief executive of the department principally assisting in the administration of the *Government Agreements Act 1979*
- 6(2)(i) to approve the appointment, for not more than two consecutive meetings, of a person nominated as a proxy for the chief executive of the department principally assisting in the administration of the *Mining Act 1978*
